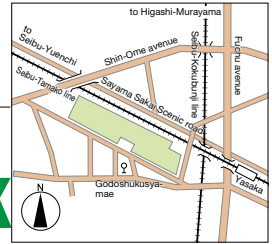


## Higashimurayama-Chuo Park

- Transport 6-minute walk from Yasaka (Seibu-Tamako line) to the park entrance, 15-minute walk from Yasaka to the park service center.  
6-minute walk from Godoshukusha-mae bus stop on Seibu Bus for Kumegawa from north exit of Tachikawa (JR Chuo line).  
Free parking available (Parking capacity is 10 cars. Please use public transportation.).



Centering around the central square of the park, bright woods of Japanese red pine and bao li grow on the east side of the park while facilities such as a bird sanctuary, playground field, snail pond, and croquet field stand on the west side. The flower bed of small chrysanthemums and the seedling field of kohigan-cherry blossoms are managed by the volunteers.

The flower bed of small chrysanthemums (florist's daisy) that blooms beautifully during autumn and the seedling field of Higan cherry are managed by volunteers.

### Bird sanctuary

This area was developed to preserve the habitat of creatures living in the park and to protect wild birds. Trees and grasses are surrounded by a fence, around which can be found a pond and sandy shore. Inside the fence is a pond where wild birds can live in safety.

An observation facility has also been set up. From that, people can view wildlife without disturbing it.
