Kodaira Cemetery was established as a metropolitan cemetery in 1948. It is 23 km away from Shinjuku to the west and located between Seibu Shinjuku Line and Shin-Ome avenue.

There are zelkova trees all along the street to the cemetery approximately for 400m and it is followed by pine trees.

After exiting Kodaira station of the Seibu Shinjuku line, there are rows of zelkova trees leading up to the park for 400m, after which rows of pine trees continue.

The 36 sections of the central area are designated for public use, and the 5 sections on the east side is covered in grass and has a friendly atmosphere.

To respect a belief that the souls of the dead will return to the earth,

trees are planted near by the entrance of the cemetery office.

The cemetery also functions as a park with grasses in the summer and cherry blossoms in the early spring. Visitors can enjoy watching azalea, hydrangea, crepe myrtle and foliage.
