● Transport About 25 and ½ hour ride to Chichijima from Takeshiba Passenger Terminal by the ferry Ogasawara-Marū.



A thousand kilometers south of central Tokyo lies this Tokyo Metropolitan park on Chichijima Island in the Ogasawara Islands. Facing the clear blue sea, Ogamiyama Park is separated into two parts, the hilly Ogamiyama area and the Omura Chuo area next to Futami port.

## Ogamiyama area

The observation deck on the top of Mt. Ogami located in front of the Chichijima island gateway of Futami pier gives a great view. One can see Futami port and the villages of Omura, Kiyose, and Okumura, as well as Mt. Yagyu, Cape Suzaki, Mt. Yowake, Mt. Asahi, Mt. Mikazuki, and Anijima Island. You can also observe many plants indigenous to the Ogasawara Islands in the park.
