Located in front of UKIMAFUNADO Station, which was opened in 1985, this lush park is surrounded by water and flowers. Ukimagaike Pond, occupying about 40% of the entire park, and the park's symbolic windmill create an impressive landscape. It offers not only rich nature but sports facilities as well.

Ukima Pond

This was once part of the main stream of the Arakawa River. Ukimagaike Pond was formed with a plot left after an embankment was constructed in the early Showa Period. Since 1977, the pond has been open to the public for fishing, free of charge.

Ukimagahara Sakura Sohojo Orchard

Many primroses used to grow naturally on the Arakawa riverbed. Wild primroses disappeared due to improvements made to the river. However, to preserve the species they were cultivated in a nursery garden in an approximately 1,600 m² plot of land inside the park.

Facilities: baseball field, tennis courts, Kodomo Undo Hiroba Square, Boken Hiroba Square, windmill, gate ball court, Chibikko Hiroba Square, Splashing Pond, Ukimagahara Primrose Farm Garden, aquatic plant garden, bird sanctuary
