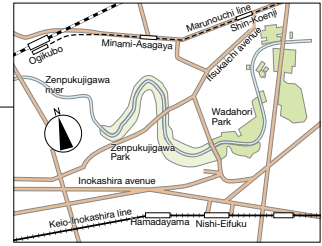


Zenpukujigawa Park

- Transport 15-minute walk from Nishi-Eifuku or Hamadayama (Keio-Inokashira line). 15-minute walk from Minami-Asagaya (Tokyo Metro Marunouchi line), Zenpukujigawa-Ryokuchi-Koen-mae, Suginami-Daini-Shogakko-mae or Itsukaichi-Kaido-Eigyosho bus stop on Kanto Bus, (Nakano to Kichijoji). Jidokotsu-Koen-iriguchi bus stop on Sugimaru Bus (Asagaya to Hamadayama).



There are two parks along the Zenpukuji river that start from the Zenpukuji pond. Two parks are situated along the river, Zenpukujigawa Green Park upstream and Wadabori Park downstream.

Children's field

There are several squares such as airplane square, buddy square, leafy shade square, and center square nicknamed by kids and loved by many people.

Cherry trees

All of the 550 cherry trees are about 40 years old that blooms spectacularly during Spring. It has become a famous place for cherry blossom, along with the neighboring Wadabori Park.



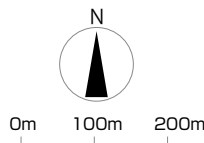
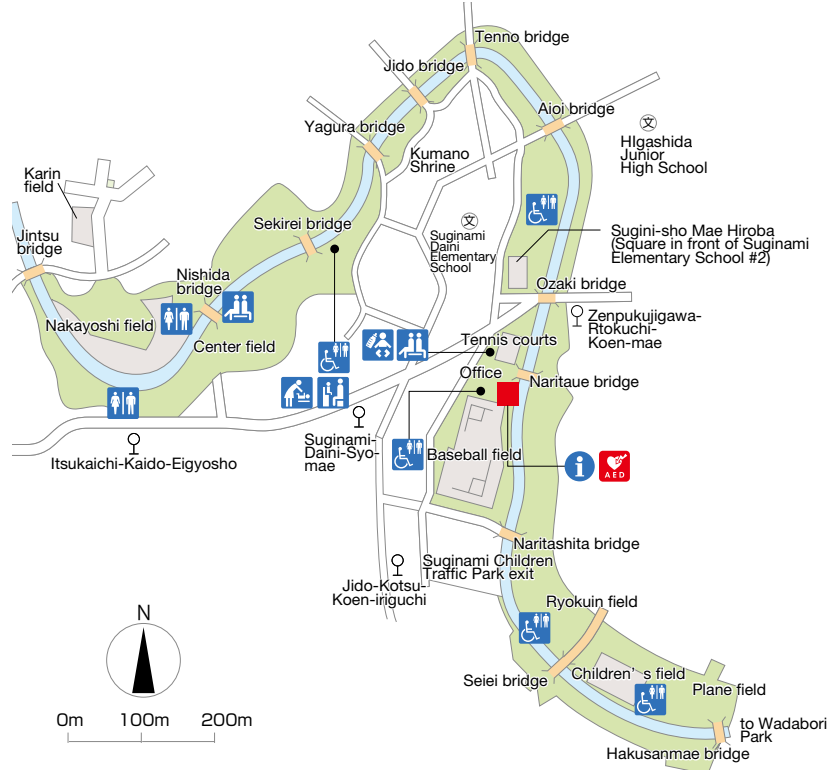
Cherry blossoms on Zunpukujigawa River

Clear stream and waterfowl

Japanese wagtails, black-backed wagtails, and little egrets can be seen along the river. Ducks travel here during the winter to rest their wings by the waterfront.
