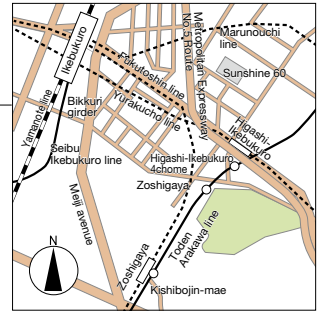

 - 20-minute walk from Ikebukuro (JR line, Marunouchi line, Yurakucho line, Fukutoshin line, Seibuline, Tobu-tojojo line).
 - 8-minute walk from Exit No.1 of Zoushigaya (Shin-Fukutoshin line).

Cemetery

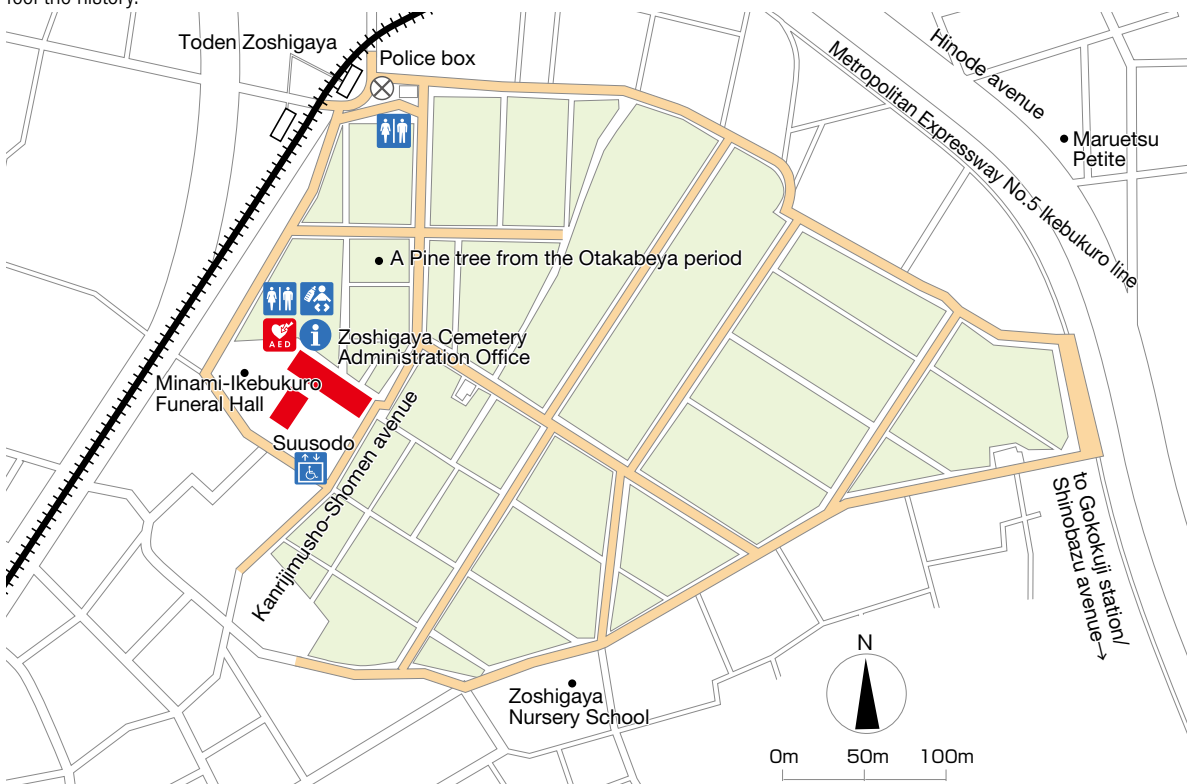
Zoushigaya Cemetery is similar to Aoyama Cemetery in that Tokyo prefecture took over it in 1874 and established it as Zoushigaya Cemetery. And then in 1889 it was transferred to Tokyo City and renamed as Zoushigaya Reien (Cemetery), which is what it is still called today.

“Susodo Hall” was built in December 1938, along with the attachment of a funeral hall and temporal lockers.

It is mostly flat, with many zelkova trees throughout. And it provides a rich natural environment to the surrounding residences. There are also many graves of public figures, and visitors can feel the history.
