This park was developed under a policy of using a part of former military bases for parks. Development was carried out considering improvement to the living environment for residents, the need for exercise facilities, and function as an evacuation center in case of disaster. There are the 300 meter long cherry blossom street "Flower-promenade" and a full range of exercise facilities for jogging, baseball, tennis, soccer, playgrounds and water play area, etc., for families and children to enjoy the park. Fuchunomori Park has the Fuchu Art Museum and eight sculptures by notable artists are located throughout the park. Visitors can also enjoy the arts in the green at the nearby Fuchunomori Art Theater.

- Main plants** Sawtooth oak, Japanese zelkova, konara oak, cherry, Himalayan cedar, orange osmanthus, camellia
- Facilities** Tennis courts, small baseball field, soccer field, hockey court, multi-use field, playground equipment field, water-edge field (splashing pond), barbeque field, art museum (administered by Fuchu City: tel: 042-336-3371)
